

Community level: Wuxi & Harbin City Pilots 2006-08

- ≥2005 an International Conference in China
- ➤ Projects: Community Level
- ➤ Organized: Subdistrict Gov(Jiedao)
- >2007:
- 28 subdistricts
- 63 projects
- Total: 75million RMB(about 12million RMB)
- General public budgetary expenditure in the two cities 120.2 billion (WU 989;Har 213)
- The local public budgetary expenditure 46.3 billion(379;84)
- Ratio: 0.62 %o; 1.6%

Central Gov level: School Nutrition Improvement Initiative



The "School Nutrition Improvement Initiative" program has covered **3.79 million** rural students (9200+ Schools) of compulsory education who live in poverty in 101 poverty-stricken counties in 14 pilot provinces




It contains three components:

- The Website of School Nutrition Improvement Initiative:
 Learn about the newest dynamic and information & Monitor
 the implementation of the plan in the rural schools
- The Mobile-phone Application for Report: Collect the daily policy implementation through the mobile-phone application
- Database: Use Cloud Technology to store the data and picture & Use SQL Sever to manage and analyze the data & Use Power BI to provide data analyses, result output, and report analyses

Background: Guangzhou



Background: Guangzhou




Population: the end of 2016, Guangzhou possesses 14.0435 million people, ranks the third among China. Urban population takes 86.06%. At the end of this year, registered population (HU KOU) reached 8.7049 million.


Economy: Local general public budget revenue reached 137.1 billion RMB Yuan.

Size and density of the city: Guangzhou, located in the south-central of Guangdong and north of the Pearl River Delta, covers an area of 7434 square kilometers and occupies 11 municipal districts. Guangzhou, as one of the starting points of Maritime Silk Route, is just across the sea from Hong Kong and Macao. It is also the core city of Guangzhou-Foshan metropolitan region, Guangdong-Hong Kong- Macao metropolitan region and the Pearl River Delta metropolitan region.

Possible approach: "Performance B"+"Participatory B"?

The Main Achievements

1. Inner the government--Reform the administrative and financial system (CDRF+Finance) "The whole process performance budget reform'

(1) Openness

- The Project Aim of Performance: 2018, city level, 8089 projects
- The evaluation outcomes open to the public.

(2) Linking up strategic planning and visioning

- People can say and give opinion on the strategic planning and the visioning
- Indicators to measure the changes and the achievements that are accessible for citizens
- Before: just open about the evaluation outcomes; now: the aim and the outcomes

(2) Scale and Quality

- 2017: 2 small and simple DEPs (disabled people organisation / intellectual property rights bureau)
- 2018: 12 DEPs; 2019, all
- Quality: performance objectives management:
- --project (above 1 million RMB yuan) the quantitative INDEX(not less than 50%, cannot be qualitative).
- --project (above 5 million RMB yuan): performance monitoring; connect to the people's congress on time

The Main Achievements

2. the selection of the projects relating people's livelihood (the DRC of the city)

- 2015, first "sea selection",
 - Fileds: employment security, social security, culture and education, medical and health, and housing, public transportation, environmental improvement, public order, food security, etc
 - The selection principle: "one year: establish- complete-got the effectiveness".
 - Just the right of suggestions
 - 5000 participants



- Targeted Research and Suggestion









The Main Challenges

1. Deliver Ability

- (1) Expectation gap: Residents' demand for quality public services is higher and higher:
- (2)**The Migration Gap**: --education case
- (3) **urban and rural Gap**:


wide income gap between urban and rural areas.





The Main Challenges

- **2. The structure of public finance expenditure:** (1) Education expenditure occupies most of the public finance expenditure of Guangzhou; (2) Livelihood expenditures occupies more than 60%; (3) Education expenditure of public finance per capita is relatively low.
- 3. Low participation
- -- suggestion vs real need
- 4. Fragmentation and the decentralization of budgetary power: Bureau of civil affairs; bureau of finance; Municipal Development and Reform Commission; Municipal People's Congress; IT Department.



Future

- **Step 1:** inner, participation as "Tool"
- Step 2: re-design Participation as "Value"
- --consensus?: Meg-city

Key Lessons

1. The local political elites

- Willingness to experiment—political determination
- Willingness to learn from other good practices
- Strong capacity to mobilize resources

2. Gradual Process

- Good tradition of transparency
- Media concern

3. Training and Forum

- The participator, practitioner, researcher and advocator in PB reform
- Better understanding of progress of current fiscal budget reform, future problems and development direction
- Promote the development of relative practice and research
