



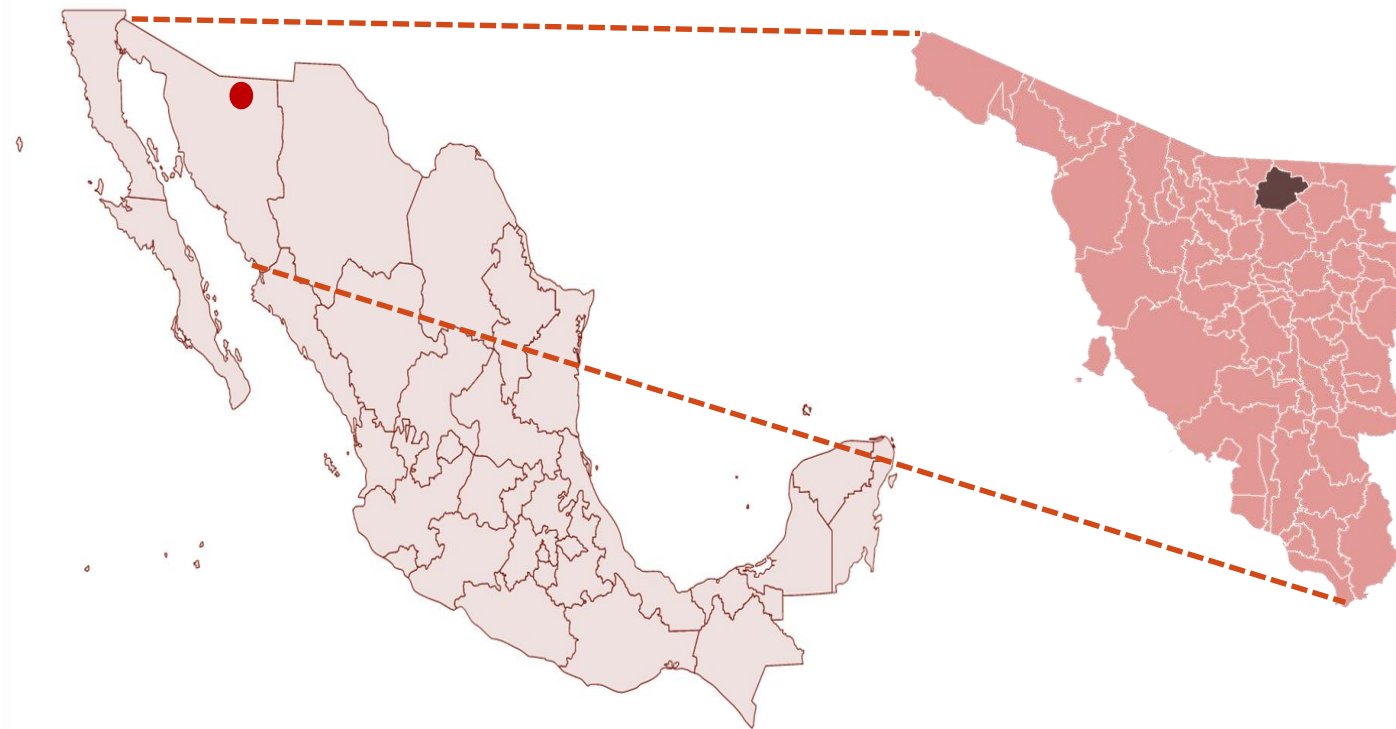

About Participatory Budget

A PB PILOT FOR THE MINING AREAS IN MEXICO

PB in Cananea: Stages and Timing



Participatory Budget and Territory



PB cover the entire municipality including 4 *ejidos* (small rural communities).

To organize the process and distribute the money across the territory, 9 Territorial Participation Units (TPU) are created.

The municipality determined 6 TPUs in the urban area, allocating 8 mp in each one, and 1 TPU for each selected ejidos, allocating 3 mp in each one.

Meetings of Public Participation

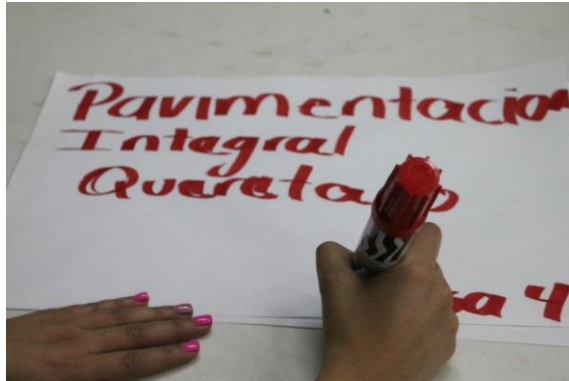


Public meetings are spaces where citizens had the opportunity to present ideas about the projects they want to carry out in their Territorial Participation Units.



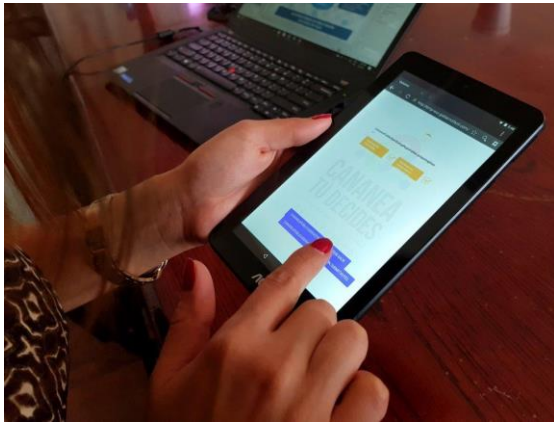
A total of 14 meetings were organized (one or two per TPU depending on their size).

Technical Analysis



The objective of the technical analysis is to make a first validation exercise considering the eligibility criteria and to develop a project profile based on the proposed ideas, incorporating an estimated costing thereof.

Public voting



Voting will be in person and using an electronic platform. Each participant can vote for two different projects, from different Territorial Participation Unit.



Results



14 meetings



615 participants



377 proposals



**34 proposals were
approved for

The thirteen winning projects were all contractualized in three months and some are already concluded

Community Monitoring Groups



In all units a volunteer citizen group was elected to monitor all phases of project implementation.

These citizens were elected at the participation meetings. Each group has 4 people, two men and two women
